

Every effort will be made to insure that participants have a safe and rewarding camp experience. Campers are:

Adequately Supervised

by county 4-H agents, district and state specialists, and camp staff. Campers will be expected to abide by 4-H behavior guidelines on the Form 600A.

Regularly Inspected

4-H center facilities meet Health Department guidelines. Professional and summer staff receive training in first aid and safety procedures.

First Aid Station

is located on the grounds. Medications for allergies and other illnesses are kept in a safe location and monitored by adults. A health care professional is employed by the 4-H Center.

Local Hospitals

Arrangements have been made for emergency care. It is the responsibility of the parents to notify 4-H agents of pertinent medical information.

Limited Accident Insurance

Delegates are covered from the time they leave home until they return. In the case of emergencies, instructions on the Activity and Event Acceptance Form are followed.

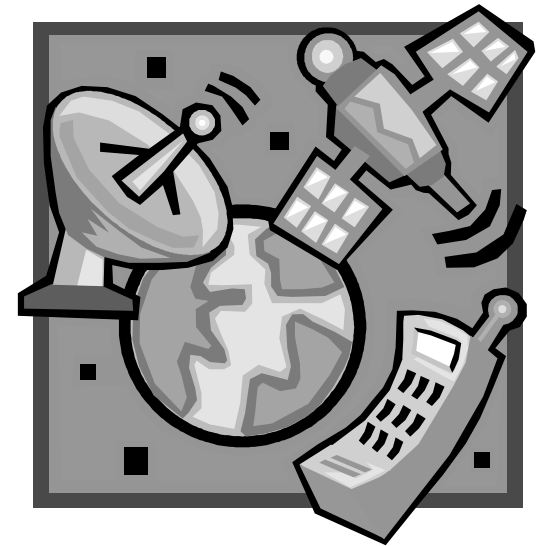
