

County 4-H Shooting Sports Instructor Position Description

- Position Title:** County Instructor in one of the disciplines (Archery, Rifle, Shotgun, Muzzleloader, or Hunting), 4-H Shooting Sports Program.
- Time Commitment:** Length of service is one year – renewable. Three-year commitment preferred. Program ranges from 8-36 hours.
- Location:** Serve within the county or area.
- Type of Position:** Volunteer key leader, no direct salary.
- Supervision:** County 4-H Shooting Sports Coordinator, and Extension professional in charge of 4-H programs.
- General Purpose:** Responsible for teaching discipline related skills to 4-H'ers, ages 10-19.

Specific Responsibilities:

- Teach shooting safety
- Coordinate activities with shooting sports coordinator
- Coach members on proper shooting techniques
- Attend shooting club meetings and activities
- Recruit and train assistant instructors
- Assist coordinator in securing needed equipment and facilities
- Recruit parents and 4-H members
- Participate in training programs specified by the sports committee
- Promote other 4-H activities and events

Qualifications:

- Age 21 or older (for archery can be 19 or older)
- Ability to work with youth and adults
- Interest in and knowledge of shooting sports
- State certification in shooting discipline, recertification as required
- Familiar with 4-H objectives and philosophy or willing to learn
