4-H ED-VENTURE CAMP (CLYDE YORK, CROSSVILLE)



4-H Ed-venture Camp is geared more toward older youth and features adventure-type and active-engaged programming, with an emphasis on individual development and group dynamics through special interest groups and team challenges. You will learn valuable teambuilding skills, and find out what it takes to be a leader. Communication and decision-making will also come more naturally to you as a result of 4-H Ed-venture Camp. The Clyde York 4-H Center is located near Crossville atop the scenic Cumberland Plateau on 194 acres, offering a variety of rustic scenery.

The Center features an air-conditioned recreation hall and dining hall, and is known for the quality of its home-cooked meals, where campers may return for seconds.

Eight air-conditioned cabins with modern bath facilities provide a restful atmosphere for campers. Accommodations for campers with disabilities are also available.

The well-maintained grounds are fenced and gated for security purposes. The modern camping facility is accredited according to the strict guidelines of the American Camp Association.

THINGS TO DO

Campers can enjoy a new Olympic-size pool with a 125-foot water slide. Two lakes allow campers to enjoy fishing, canoeing, kayaking and even a paddleboat ride. Campers can also create projects at the woodworking center or T-shirt shop. Other facilities include a covered basketball court, sports fields, a wildlife center and adventure challenge courses. Other activities may include horseback riding, caving, hiking, tubing, and rock or wall climbing. An outdoor theater is the backdrop for campfires and vespers. A canteen offers refreshing snack items.
